Although many of the citizens are hard-working, there is little work and the wages are minimal. The drug cartels control most of the neighborhoods. Many families are unable to afford even a simple single room house, especially the widows and orphans that we serve. Imagine a house which is smaller than most of our bedrooms and has no indoor plumbing or electricity. There it's considered an unbelievable blessing. And all of us come back receiving much more than we have given, while confirming the reality, that it really is better to give than receive.

With your help, we will provide three more families with a small one room house.
Please join us as we seek to fulfill the dreams of three families.

We ask that you would prayerfully consider supporting the building costs.

SOS Ministries and Paul Gonzalez, the local pastor in Matamoros that lives there among the poor, will purchase most of the building materials in Mexico with money

donated by our group and others like you. Each house costs about \$2,500. We will collect donated windows, doors, paint, and toys to take with us. Designscape pays for our food, lodging, and transportation, out of our profits from our landscaping work. If there happens to be any donations left over, they will be presented to SOS ministries for future mission work.
